



- “Supporting the mobility of students, staff and researchers and the development of strategic partnerships and joint courses by increasing HE internationalisation”

Facts about the project




- EU Erasmus+ project (2015-2017)
- Ministry level initiative
- Increase student mobility (20%)
- Recognition of previous studies
- Electronic and secure transfer of student data between HEIs
- Denmark, Finland, Italy, Norway, Poland, Sweden

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Benefits for higher education

- **Fast and easy-to-use tool for fetching achievement records**
- Significantly increases the availability, quality and recognition of degrees and credits
- Reduces the risk of overlapping studies
- Diminishes the risk of forged transcripts and/or certificates
- Reduces the administrative workload, saving time and money
- Promotes student mobility

Students used to google – demand fast and online services

More benefits

- National/European Mobility targets - increases student mobility and crediting
- Enables automatic recognition of studies
- Mobility statistic – reliable and aggregated data
- Non-HEIs e.g. government/student support agencies
- Turnkey solution for connecting existing systems:
 - Easy tool to implement locally
 - Student authorization (no new contracts)
 - Local infrastructure (data warehouses, authentication) to be utilized

Welcome! With this service you can retrieve your achievement records from studies at another university or college. Importing your records is a quick and easy process.

1. Select the country from which you want to retrieve your achievement records
2. Use the credentials from the host university where you studied to log into the system where your results are stored.
– You will be able to import results from all the universities you studied at in that country (if part of EMREX)
3. Select the achievement records you want to import
4. Review and confirm the selection. The records will be sent to your home university and you will be sent a copy if you'd like.
5. Afterwards you will be asked to answer a few questions about the tool to help us develop it further.
